NOTIFICATION OF COUNTY APPRAISER CHANGE

To: Director of Property Valuation

K.S.A. 19-432(d) requires the board of county commissioners or governing body of any unified government to notify the director of property valuation, on a form provided by the director, when a person no longer holds the office of county appraiser for such county. If the person no longer holds the office of county appraiser before the expiration of a four-year term or the person does not complete a four-year term, then the notification shall include the reason therefor, unless otherwise precluded by law.

This letter is to notify you the following appraiser no longer holds the office of county appraiser for the current appointed term. The director shall make a notation on any eligibility list record of the person when the person no longer holds the office of county appraiser before the expiration of a four-year term or the person does not complete a four-year term.
